Capitol Hill Challenge™

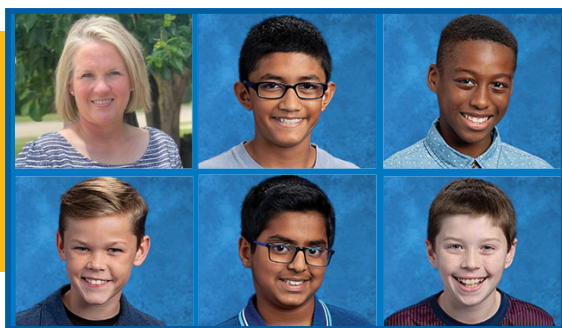
THE PROGRAM The Capitol Hill Challenge™ (CHC) presented by the Charles Schwab Foundation, is a special edition of The Stock Market Game™ offered every spring. CHC matches Members of Congress with students, teachers, and schools in their respective district or state and has drawn 100% Congressional participation each year. Since its inception in 2004, CHC has made over 5,500 Congressional matches with schools, reaching more than 133,000 students across the country.

CHC is offered free of charge and by invitation from the SIFMA Foundation, with priority consideration given to underserved Title I public middle and high schools. Student teams manage a hypothetical \$100,000 online portfolio and invest in real stocks, bonds, mutual funds, impact investments, and cash. At the end of the program, the top 10 performing teams win prizes and national recognition, plus the opportunity to engage directly with government and business leaders, virtually or in person.

THE VALUE CHC students learn about the global capital markets and the importance of long-term saving and investing, while developing integral workplace skills such as collaboration and critical thinking. CHC also provides Members of Congress an opportunity to connect with schools in their districts and to inspire and serve as role models.
